SIR:

I transmit herewith Volume III of the Fifteenth Census Reports on Population. This volume, which is printed in two parts, presents statistics showing the composition and characteristics of the population by States, counties, and townships or other minor civil divisions, with figures for cities and other incorporated places having a population of 1,000 or more. Part 1 contains a summary for the United States, and the statistics for the several States, arranged alphabetically, from Alabama to Missouri. Part 2 presents the statistics for the remaining States, from Montana to Wyoming.

The census of population was taken as of April 1, 1930, in conformity with the "Act providing for the Fifteenth Census and for the Apportionment of Representatives in Congress," approved June 18, 1929. The results of the census of population are contained in six volumes, as follows: Volume I, Number and Distribution of Inhabitants; Volume II, General Report—Statistics by Subjects; Volume III, Reports by States, Showing the Composition and Characteristics of the Population for Counties, Cities, and Townships or Other Minor Civil Divisions; Volume IV, Occupations, by States; Volume V, General Report on Occupations; Volume VI, Families. The results of the census of unemployment, which was taken in conjunction with the census of population, are contained in two volumes, as follows: Volume I, Unemployment Returns by Classes for States, Counties, and Cities; Volume II, General Report on Unemployment.

The collection and compilation of the statistics of population and unemployment, including the preparation of this volume, were under the supervision of Dr. Leon E. Truesdell, chief statistician for population, assisted by Olive M. Riddleberger, assistant chief statistician.
